6. **Related books** (at least 3) and how they compare to yours.
7. **Table of contents** including a brief summary of each chapter.
8. **Timeline and testing**: How long it will take to complete, and what kind of audience testing and feedback you expect to receive.
9. **Potential reviewers**: 3-4 example scholars who would be appropriate reviewers for your work.
10. **Relevant journals** in which a review of your book would be appropriate.
11. **Publisher feedback** if some or all of the manuscript has been evaluated elsewhere.
